- a. Two things that were considered deviant in the past but are not considered deviant now (2)**

- b. One thing that is considered deviant now, but was not considered deviant in the past (1)**

- c. Two things that are considered deviant in our society but are not considered deviant in another society (2)**

- d. One thing considered deviant in another society that is not considered deviant in our society (1)**

3. Identify and explain:

- a. Something that is considered deviant for men but not for women (1)**

- b. Something that is considered deviant for women but not for men (1)**

- c. Something that is considered deviant for adults but not for children (1)**

- d. Something that is considered deviant for children but not for adults (1)**

- e. Two things that are considered deviant for one ethnic group but not for another ethnic group (2)**
